

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

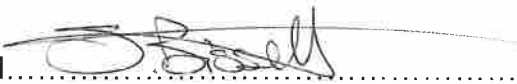
1. The name of the school is **Marsh Baldon Church of England Controlled Primary School.**
2. The school is a Voluntary Controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is **"The governing body of Marsh Baldon Church of England Controlled Primary School."**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. **Two** parent governors
 - b. **One** LA governor
 - c. **One** staff governor
 - d. **One** Headteacher
 - e. **Two** foundation governors
 - f. **Three** co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors shall be **ten**, except that, at any time when the head teacher has given written notice to the clerk to the governors that he/she chooses not to be a governor, the total shall be **nine**.
6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by the **Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.**
7. The school has a trust deed dated **15 August 1873.**
8. The school's ethos statement

"Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan levels.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils."

9. This instrument of government comes into effect on **1 September 2016.**

10. This instrument was made by order of **Oxfordshire Local Authority on 26 February 2016.**
