Boats were the earliest form of transport - 10,000 years ago

6,000 years ago (4000 BC) humans domesticated horses. Mostly commonly used 2-3 hundred years ago.

200 years ago trains became popular.

130 years ago bikes became popular.

100 years ago cars were invented. Only available for most people 60 years ago.

70 years ago plane travel started to be more popular.
