

Reception Art and Design Painting and Mixed Media: Paint My World

Exploring paint and painting techniques through nature, music and collaborative work.

Key Knowledge:

Colour: The names of a wide range of colours.

Colour: Colours can be mixed to make new colours.

Line: Lines can be curved or straight and described in simple terms such as: wiggly, 'straight', 'round'.

Pattern: When they have made a pattern with objects/colours/drawn marks to be able to describe it.

Texture: Simple terms to describe what something feels like (e.g. bumpy)

Key Skills:

Talk about their ideas and explore different ways to record them using a range of media. Experiment in an exploratory way.

Use a range of drawing materials, art application techniques, mixed-media scraps and modelling materials to create child-led art with no set outcome.

Enjoy looking at and talking about art.

Recognise that artists can be inspired by many things.

Talk about their artwork, stating what they feel they did well. Say if they like an artwork or not and begin to form opinions by explaining why.

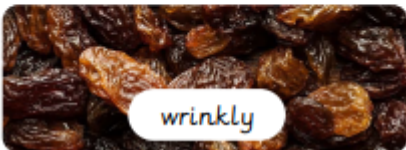

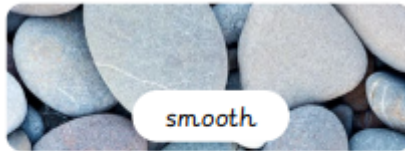

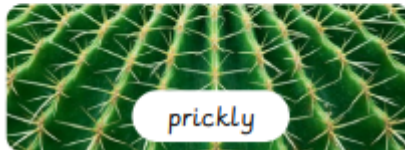
