Science

Animals Including Humans

In this unit we will learn about:

- The human digestive system
- The role of different types of teeth for humans and animals
- Energy transfer in food chains

English

We will be using 'Journey' by Aaron Becker as our writing stimulus this term. This is the first book in a trilogy of wordless stories. We will be making predictions, describing settings and building our own version of the narrative.

RE

Our big question this term is

- Reality and Truth (Philosophy)
