### Key Knowledge:

Christians learn about God from the bible.

Christians use different names for God.

### Vocabulary:

**Bible** - The Christian holy book consisting of the Old Testament and the New Testament.

**Parables** - a simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson, as told by Jesus in the Gospels.

**Gospel** - one of the first four New Testament books telling of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

**Miracle** - an extraordinary and welcome event that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws.

**Belief** - an acceptance that something exists or is true, especially one without proof.

**The Holy Trinity** - the Christian belief that God is one single divine Being who exists as three distinct persons at the same time.
